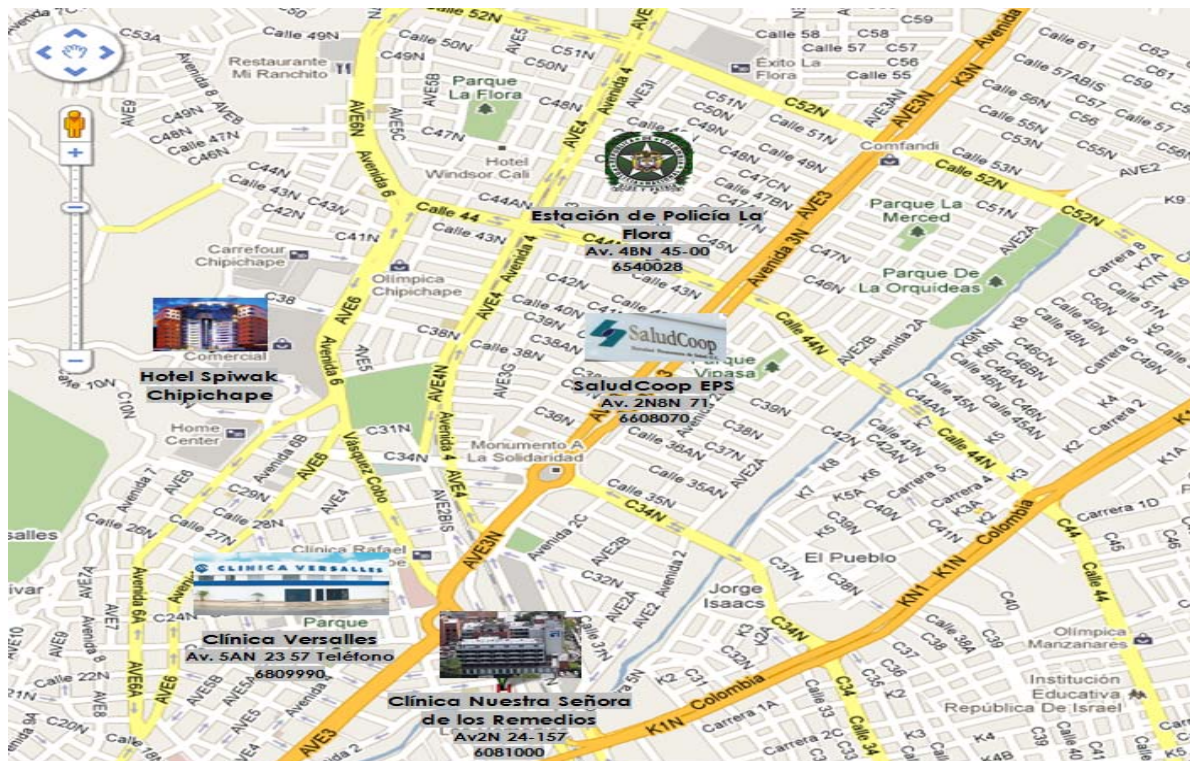
GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Place and date of event

The Seminar on “**Accident Investigation**” LACAC/CAAS will be held from 22 to 26 August, 2011, in Santiago de Cali, Colombia.

3. Inscripción

5. Languages

The working language will be English, with English/Spanish simultaneous interpretation.

9. Travel documents

Foreign citizens should be credited with passports. Depending on the country of origin may require a visa.

10. International Embarkation Fee

Generally the airport fee is included in the cost of tickets for the delegates, if not included, the cost is USD 83.00.

11. Temperature

Cali has a temperature about 28 ° C are considered warm - wet to be near the equator. From December to March and from July to August is the cycle known as the dry season and temperatures range between 19 ° C (66 ° F) and a maximum of 34 ° C (93 ° F).

12. Local currency and money Exchange

Colombia's currency is the Colombian peso.

Circulating Coins: \$ 50, \$ 100, \$ 200 and \$ 500.

Circulating bills, \$ 1,000, \$ 2,000, \$ 5,000, \$ 10,000, \$ 20,000 and \$ 50,000.

The exchange rate is subject to change. To date (July 15, 2011), the TMR is to 1757, according to the Bank of the Republic of Colombia.

The exchange can be made at the offices of commercial banks or authorized exchange houses. Additionally, some hotels provide this service to its guests.

13. Credit Cards

International credit cards such as MasterCard, Visa, American Express, etc. are usually accepted in major hotels, shops and restaurants.

14. Business schedule

Shops are open Monday to Saturday from 10:00 to 20:00 hours.

15. Electric power

In Colombia domestic electricity is 110 V AC, 60 Haz. Electrical connectors or plugs used in Colombia are American type, with both feet flat input (plug type A) or with a third round pin (plug type B). In the market you can find adapters for these outlets, especially for devices with European plugs (plug type C or Europlug), but for other types of connectors, you must go to specialty stores electricity.

18. Tips, taxes an taxi services

The recommended gratuity is 10% of the cost incurred. In most cases, tipping is not included in the price of meals or any other service.

The tax on purchases and services called the Value Added Tax (IVA in Spanish), currently is 16% of the value of the bought.

In the transport sector (taxis or other) is not usual to tip the drivers, being at the discretion of the passenger to do it or not.

19. Security recommendations

Security recommendations are the common ones to all great cities, such as to carry only the necessary money, not to exhibit valuable jewels and to ask for radiotaxi at the Hotel of your choice to go to any part of the city.

21. General Information of Guatemala City

Located in Colombia, South America, Valle del Cauca is one of the richest departments and greater economic development and trade of the Republic of Colombia. Located in the southwest of the country and has 200 kilometers of coastline on the Pacific Ocean, where is located the port of Buenaventura, the largest in the country, the vast movement of cargo import and export.

The Cauca Valley has a total area of 21,195 km² which represents 1.5% of the country, its population certified by the National Administrative Department of Statistics at the last census in the year 2005, was 4,052,535.

The Cauca Valley has varied climatic conditions, being 25 degrees Celsius average temperature, to a height of 1000 meters above sea level. The Pacific coast region has rainfall reaching 5000 mm per year. The

department has 42 municipalities administratively and its capital Santiago de Cali and is 484 km away from Bogotá, the capital. The 81.85% of the population is concentrated vallecaucana in urban and 18.2% in the areas.
