9. Currency

Currency is Argentinian peso

10. Credit Cards

11. Business Hours

The shops are open from Monday to Sunday from 10:00 a.m. At 8:00 p.m.

12. Travel documents

We recommend check it before buy air tickets.

13. Boarding Fee

Boarding fee must be included in air ticket.

14. Tips and Taxes

The recommended tip is 10% of the expense incurred. Usually the tip is suggested at the end of the bill and it is optional to include it or not.

Sales and services are taxed with the General Sales Tax (IGV), which currently stands at 21% of the value of the acquisitions. In transport (taxis or others) it is not customary to tip drivers, remaining at the discretion of the passenger.

15. Security Recommendations

The security recommendations are the same for all cities, as carrying only the necessary money, no valuable jewelry and order a safety taxi. Hotel taxis are recommended.
