1. Place and date

Seminar will be conducted in English with simultaneous interpretation to Spanish.

8. Weather

Temperature in October is range between 9° y 22°.

9. Electricity

Electricity in Ecuador is 120 V, 60 Haz. Plugs are A/B.

10. Credit cards and rate change

The local currency is U.S Dollars.

Credit cards such as Visa, MasterCard and American Express are commonly accepted in hotels, shops and restaurants.

11. Business hours

Business hours from 10 to 20hrs, Monday to Friday and 10 to 19hrs, Saturdays.

Shopping Centers from 10 to 21hrs, Monday to Sunday.

12. Taxes and tips

The tax on purchases is included in consumer prices. Tipping at restaurants is included in the bill and is usually 10% of the bill.

The safety recommendations are similar to those to follow in any large city, such as carrying only the amount of money needed, not displaying jewelry or high-value jewelry and requesting taxi services at hotels to go anywhere in the city.
